1 Be it resolved by the body of Republican Committee of \_\_\_\_\_ County in AZ:

2  
3 WHEREAS, Ben Toma/Warren Petersen is a Republican Arizona State  
4 Representative/State Senator who is refusing to uphold their oath of office in  
5 A.R.S 38-231;

6 WHEREAS, Ben Toma/Warren Petersen is refusing to defend the laws of the State  
7 of Arizona and the Constitution of the United States;

8  
9 WHEREAS, under the authority of Republican AZ State legislature, AZ state  
10 legislature's legal council wrote a false " Mueller Report " style Memo against  
11 our fight to protect election integrity and against our fight to prevent  
12 election fraud, in a salacious attempt to confuse our wonderful AZ citizens &  
13 our spectacular AZ Precinct Committeemen on what the Republican AZ state  
14 legislature is refusing to do which is fight for election integrity and get  
15 tough on Hobbs;

16 WHEREAS, the citizens commanded 56<sup>th</sup> Arizona state legislature to protect &  
17 enact election integrity with notices on January 1<sup>st</sup>, January 14<sup>th</sup>, February 1<sup>st</sup>  
18 2023 by ordering the AZ state legislature to compel compliance of AZ election  
19 law in Arizona Revised Statutes Title 16, by adding an exception to any  
20 County's (including Maricopa county's) state shared revenue and ensure at least  
21 3 meaningful election integrity bills are on the negotiating table & signed by  
22 the AZ Governor before appropriating all monies to the AZ Governor's 9<sup>th</sup> floor  
23 in the AZ state annual budget;

24 WHEREAS, AZ State Speaker of the House Ben Toma/AZ State Senate President  
25 warren Petersen on November 15, 2022 re-appointed Rusty Bowers' Chief of Staff  
26 Michael Hunter for the AZ State House;

27 WHEREAS, On March 16<sup>th</sup> 2023 it was publicly stated on the Mike Broomhead show by  
28 AZ State Senator Steve Kaiser (LD2) that zoning reform in SB1117 is the most  
important bill to the 2023 56<sup>th</sup> Republican AZ State legislature: " this is the  
most important bill of the session, " per AZ State Senate President Warren  
Petersen;

3 WHEREAS, United States Constitution Article 1 Section 4 Clause 1, United States  
4 Constitution Article 2 Section 1 Clause 2, is the highest and supreme law of  
5 the land in the State of Arizona and the United States of America on elections  
6 which granted the AZ State legislature their responsibility & authority of  
7 elections and the AZ State legislature is in charge of elections;

8  
9 WHEREAS, Maricopa county as the operator of the elections and a civil division  
10 of the state does not have 14th amendment rights to USURP the AZ state  
11 legislature's federal/state Constitutional authority of elections;

12  
13 WHEREAS, in this current 2023 AZ State 56th legislative session; there are  
14 several Republican AZLeg members who have sponsored SB1137 - " Maricopa county;  
15 division; new counties, " & SB1137 single's out Maricopa County dividing it up  
16 into 4 new Maricopa counties, 4 Maricopa Counties would mean 4 new Bill Gates,  
17 4 new Stephen Richers, 4 new Jack Sellers and 4 new Scott Jarretts, all *mostly*  
18 under the same AZ election laws from 2020/2022, as a reminder under the  
19 authority of Republican AZ State legislature, AZ state legislature's legal  
20 council memo 03/15/2023 falsely stated its unconstitutional to single out  
21 Maricopa County;

22  
23 WHEREAS, the AZ state legislature has the vested legislative authority (power  
24 to make laws), writes the state annual budget (power of the purse), disburses  
25 money to Counties as state shared revenue, sets the times places and manner of  
26 holding elections; appoints US Presidential electors for Arizona, has state  
27 house/state senate chambers, both state house and state senate make their own  
28 rules, also during each AZ state legislative session the AZ state legislature  
can change, amend or repeal their own rules at any time of their choosing with  
a simple majority vote;

29  
30 WHEREAS, Article 4 Section 4 " guarantee a Republican form of government, " in  
31 our Republic within our pledge of allegiance;

32  
33 WHEREAS, Arizona State Constitution Preamble, Articles 1 and 2, specifically  
34 establishes all political power to the people, fundamental principles essential

1 to the security of individual rights/free government & that these powers are  
2 inherent to the people;

3  
4 WHEREAS, Arizona Constitution Article 2 Section 21: All elections shall be free  
5 and equal, and no power, civil or military, shall at any time interfere to  
6 prevent the free exercise of the right of suffrage and Arizona Constitution  
7 Article 7 Section 7: In all elections held by the people in this state, the  
8 person, or persons, receiving the highest number of legal votes shall be  
9 declared elected;

10 WHEREAS, Maricopa County violated the Arizona State election  
11 laws/procedures/statutes, performing misconduct in maladministration & election  
12 fraud that impacted the outcome of both general elections of 2020 and 2022;

13  
14 WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statute 42-5029 subsection D states: “ Of the monies  
15 designated as distribution base, the department shall: 2. Pay 38.08 percent to  
16 the counties in this state by averaging the following proportions: The  
17 proportion that the population of each county bears to the total state  
18 population, “;

19  
20 WHEREAS, the Arizona State annual budget includes the Arizona state shared  
21 revenues which are distributed to all 15 counties of AZ, and voted on by all  
22 AZ State Representatives and all AZ State Senators by invoking Arizona Revised  
23 Statute 42-5029 subsection D in the written text of the AZ state annual budget;

24  
25 WHEREAS, Arizona State Constitution Article 9 Section 5, states “ No money  
26 shall be paid out of the state treasury except in the manner provided by law,”  
27 and in Article 9 Section 20 states the legislature inherently sets the  
28 “ expenditure limitation.....for each county, “;

1 WHEREAS, the people with all political power, inherently reserves the right to  
2 hold our 56<sup>th</sup> Arizona state legislature accountable for their failure to serve  
3 the citizens of Arizona;

4  
5 WHEREAS, AZ State Speaker of the House Ben Toma/AZ State Senate President  
6 warren Petersen, is refusing to follow the Constitutional  
7 orders/demands/commands of their citizens and Republican committeemen of  
8 \_\_\_\_\_ County in AZ;

9 **Be it Resolved**, that Republican Committee of \_\_\_\_\_ County in AZ,  
10 censures AZ State Speaker of the House Ben Toma/AZ State Senate President Warren  
11 Petersen.

12  
13 **Be it further Resolved**, until Ben Toma/Warren Petersen motions the  
14 Arizona State House & State Senate to compel compliance of AZ election law in Arizona  
15 Revised Statutes Title 16, by adding an exception to any County's (including Maricopa  
16 county's) state shared revenue and ensure at least 3 meaningful election integrity  
17 bills are on the negotiating table & signed by the AZ Governor before appropriating  
18 all monies to the AZ Governor's 9<sup>th</sup> floor in the AZ state annual budget, We the  
19 Republican Committee of \_\_\_\_\_ County in AZ will not support, campaign,  
20 donate, fundraise or vote for AZ State Speaker of the House Ben Toma/AZ State Senate  
21 President Warren Petersen who doesn't represent the great people of \_\_\_\_\_ County  
22 or the citizens of the State of Arizona.
